Paving Work Coming Soon

In our continuous efforts to improve our community, the Village of Sodus is currently undertaking two paving projects. The first is on Robinson Road/Mill Street and the second is on Orchard Terrace.

As schedules and the weather allow, we expect to be laying a layer of blacktop Wednesday, August 16th. This will cause minor inconveniences for anyone traveling on these streets. Once the equipment has moved out of the way, the street surfaces will be drivable.

The second step for this process is to chip seal both streets. This thin coat of oil and stone will strengthen and protect the fresh blacktop. This work is scheduled for August 23rd and will cause **moderate inconvenience** for residents and travelers. This is a slower process, and it may **block driveways and restrict traffic to one-way for thirty to sixty minutes** at a time. Anyone with a tight schedule on August 23rd is urged to allow extra time or make **alternate arrangements** for that day. We will make every effort to minimize the impact this work will have on your life, and we appreciate your patience and understanding.
